Combined Armies Preparing to March Southward on to the Capital.

All Chihuahua Hails Him as New Leader and Raises Money For Him.

Sends Seventy Cars of Artillery North to Meet Orozco and Rebels.

EL PASO HELD AS MEXICAN SPY

JUAREZ REBELS REACH CHIHUAHUA

TAKES CADETS FROM SCHOOL TO FIGHT

Sentenced to Be Shot—Mexican Held For Ransom; Father Pinto Pays.

Gen. Salazar and his staff who left Juarez on a special train of four box cars drawn by North Western engine No. 42 at 9:25 Monday night, reached Chihuahua at 10 o'clock Monday morning, according to reports received at Gen. Rojas's headquarters in Juarez.

Mexico City, Mexico, March 5.—As in the last days of the presidency of Porfirio Diaz, the military school at Tlalpan, a suburb of the capital, is to be called upon to release its third and fourth year students for service at the front. It is expected that 100 of them will be given their commissions and sent north immediately.

Gen. Salazar and his staff who left Juarez on a special train of four box cars drawn by North Western engine No. 42 at 9:25 Monday night, reached Chihuahua at 10 o'clock Monday morning, according to reports received at Gen. Rojas's headquarters in Juarez.

The troops now in Chihuahua, reinforced by the rebels from the north and those being constantly recruited now at Chihuahua, make by conservative estimate, 2000 troops that will march on the Mexican capital before this week ends.

Gen. Pascual Orozco is to be met with a stubborn resistance in his march toward the south. Seventy cars of light and heavy artillery started from here for Tlalpan today.

Gen. Campa's forces were said to have gone into Chihuahua Monday night. No details of the meeting between Orozco and Campa or of the reception accorded the troops from the north by the people of Chihuahua were given in the dispatch received over the Mexican National telegraph lines.

Mex from the wealthiest classes, also professional and working men, are openly declaring against the present incumbent.

Gen. Angel Garcia Pena will succeed Gen. Gonzalez Salas as minister of war in President Madero's cabinet. Salas, with Col. Blanquet, the hero of many battles in Morelos and Cuernavaca, will head a column of 800 regulars, including a battery of six heavy cannons, who immediately will leave for the Toluca district. The troops consist in large part of those campaigning against Zapata Morelos.

These will join Orozco in large numbers, and march through to Mexico City.

It is considered by the war department that the rebels in the southern part of Mexico, who have been a part of the 800 men until recently operating in Morelos can only be completely destroyed if the forces already sent to Jalisco from Saltillo and Monterrey, officials say, will be able to open the way to Tlalpam and subdue the rebels in that vicinity.
