Three Are Submitted from This County at Austin.

Austin, Texas, March 5.—In the court of criminal appeals today the cases of Joe Elva and Dan Slain, from El Paso county, were submitted on oral argument by both the state and attorney for the appellants. Both were convicted on the charge of the theft of two horses and Elva was given three years and Slain four years. The case of Estevan Griego, from El Paso county, was submitted on brief for the state. Griego was given three years in the penitentiary, charged with theft of soap from a warehouse.
