HOME RULE BILL FOR IRELAND IS OUTLINED. London, England, April 5.—According to an evening paper, which quotes an unnamed Nationalist member of parliament as authority, the Irish home rule bill to be introduced by premier Asquith in the house of commons April 11 will provide for an Irish parliament to consist of two houses, which will sit at Dublin. Forty Irish members will be sent to the house of commons at Westminster. Other provisions are: Ireland will make no direct contribution to the imperial revenue. The customs and excise of Ireland will remain under imperial control, but the local parliament will have the power to vary the duties on articles

although it may not vary the articles themselves. The taxation of Ireland is to continue to be in consonance with the financial system of the United Kingdom. The old age pensions and land purchase schemes are to remain under imperial responsibility. The Irish parliament will have no power to impose duty on British goods.
