### INTERVENTION IN CUBA POSSIBLE

today with increased rapidity, however. It was noticeable that very few negroes are offering to enlist.

The report that a band of armed blacks was operating at Mariño in the immediate vicinity of Havana was denied, but rumors are current that bands of rebels are appearing in other parts of the province.

**Volunteers Ready.**

A column of volunteer veterans is about to depart for the province of Oriente, under the command of general Emilio Ximenes, president of the Veterans' association. It probably will number 1000 men who, moreover, will be materially strengthened by recruits on the way.

Secretary of the Interior, Laredo Bru said today that the government fully expected to receive most favorable reports from the front before night.

It is rumored today that the strike of longshoremen and lightermen, which was suspended two weeks ago, pending negotiations for arbitration, is likely to be resumed. This would

have serious results as it would cripple the military strength of the government by cutting off the customs receipts on which it is dependent for the transportation, equipment, pay and arming of the new levies now being enrolled.

**Shipments of Provisions Cease.**

Shipments into the country districts of provisions and other necessities of life from the city of Havana have practically ceased. The merchants are unable to make collections and their unwillingness to risk loss of their goods on account of the disturbed condition of the country is productive of great hardships throughout the island.

The government continues to profess that it has not received any news from the front in the province of Oriente. Officials declare the number of the insurgents to be vastly exaggerated, and say that those in the field possess few arms. Old campaigners in the province of Oriente however, say a mounted negro armed with a box of matches is more efficiently equipped than with a carbine or machete.

**Ships to Rendezvous at N. Y.**

Owing to the urgency of the situation, word was passed to the navy to hold itself subject for call, and early this afternoon, two divisions of the great Atlantic fleet were under orders to rendezvous at New York and Hampton Roads.

Here. All have been driven across into Mexico.

Juan Sada, the merchant at Boquilla, Mexico, just across the river from here, says there is much uneasiness there. His consulate evening he called at the consulate and offered to surrender himself and his 600 men, the consul declares.

### GEN. BLANCO IS TO BE HERE ON MONDAY

Consul Lorente Says Federal General Will Command in Sonora.

Gen. Jose de la Luz Blanco, federal and former Maderista, will arrive in El Paso the first of the week en route to Hermosillo to take command of the federal contingent in that state. Mexican consul E. C. Lorente says. It was reported on the streets and in Juarez Saturday that Gen. Blanco was already here, but the consul says he has not appeared at the consulate.

The Mexican consul gives the Orozco revolution just one month to live. He says that Gen. Huerta will march to the city of Chihuahua as soon as the bridges are repaired.

"There will be no fight at Juarez," he says. "That is sure. The government has a sufficient number of men in the state of Chihuahua to stop any attempt to cross the border and take the town. The railroad communication will be destroyed between Juarez and Chihuahua and the rebels will be forced to surrender."

Col. Gonzalez, commander of 600 rebels in the state of Puebla has offered to surrender, the consul says.

**BUFORD WITH REFUGEES IS AT MAZATLAN, RETURNING**  
Mazatlan, Mex., May 25.—Returning northward from her cruise along the Mexican coast, with 265 refugees aboard, the United States transport Buford, commanded by Capt. Ely, arrived here yesterday.

Five cases of typhoid fever among the refugees were reported, all said to be doing well.

Below San Blas the Buford passed and exchanged courtesies with the British gunboat Algerine.

At Manzanillo, where was stationed the Mexican gunboat Guerrero, Capt. Ely entertained the commander of that vessel.

Some of the federals were recognized as former El Pasoans, one of them is a former Indian from Downing. They are evidently a small band recruited at or near El Paso and sent down into that region from some point west of El Paso.
