This Is Declaration of Reitman Concerning San Diego Police Chief.

Spokane, Wash., June 21.—Dr. Ben Reitman, anarchist, who recently was expelled from San Diego and given coat of tar and sage brush, declared yesterday that chief of police Wilson, of San Diego, would be assassinated.

As John Sullivan, late chief of police of Spokane, died with a bullet in his heart, he said, "so will chief 'Keno' Wilson of the San Diego department meet his fate."

In the free speech fight in Spokane, Sullivan caused many Industrial Workers were to be imprisoned. One of these sought revenge and Sullivan paid the penalty. It will be so in San Diego, where hundreds of Industrial Workers have been beaten and cast in jail.

Chief Sullivan was killed in January, 1911, by a shot fired through the window of his home as he sat reading. No trace of the assassin has been found.


