CAMPAIGN TO WIN OVER SPANISH AMERICANS PLANNED BY CHURCHES

Effort to Be Made to Do Away With Hatred of Americans; Many New York Churches Forced to Sell Out by Expanding Subways of the City; Mission Conferences Planned in 50 Cities.

Spanish Americans, separated by their language from people with whom they live, number 750,000 and more throughout the United States.

Under the auspices of the Home Mission Council, in which are joined all Protestant missionary societies, there has just been held a conference to determine the character of work to be done among and for these Spanish speaking people.

Practically all of these Spanish Americans are laboring people, a large proportion of them in the mining and agricultural regions.



How the Modern Science Of Archaeology Confirms the Narrative Of Hebrew Scriptures

WE all like to see the stories of the Bible, which in our youth, at least, we read with wonder and veneration, confirmed, in some of the most interesting details, by the results of modern exploration.

The Civic Improvement league will hold its regular business meeting Tuesday afternoon at 8 o'clock.


