CALIFORNIA is about to pass a very sensible motor regulatory measure. It fixes a tax on automobiles, but does not make the tax heavy, and it gives the automobilist some protection in return for his tax.

Whether motor cars or otherwise, to not less than 12 miles an hour in the business district or less than 20 miles an hour within the boundaries of the municipality, and such municipalities must place on the main highways at the corporate limits and wherever the speed changes, signs indicating the speed limits and of sufficient size to be easily legible.
