LEASING SYSTEM PUZZLES ARIZONA

(Continued From Page 1)

into effect. It is a modified leasing bill and provides merely that the terms of lease shall extend until the legislature makes other arrangements for disposing of the land. Nothing is to be allowed for improvements.

This latter provision, declared Sims, is unconstitutional. Roberts declared that the bill was drawn merely to preclude the people against any kind of a leasing system. Roberts, Vessel and Harrison had presented a minority report from the land committee recommending indefinite postponement.

Get Opinion of Attorney.
Worsley characterized as absurd the contention that the legislature cannot make any kind of a contract it chooses in leasing lands that have not heretofore been under lease. He contended that that section of the constitution requiring that leases of school lands be paid for improvements upon relinquishing their leases applies only to persons who already hold such lands and have acquired vested rights.

It was finally agreed that Davis, who is chairman of the land committee,

should take the matter up with the attorney general and get his opinion.

Taxation Measure.
In all but one item the senate concurred in the house amendments to senate bill No. 22, the general taxation measure. The house changed the bill to provide that when assessments are fought in court the cases shall be heard with or without juries. The senate conference committee held out for juries in all such cases, and was upheld by the senators. Again the bill went to conference.

Confer Over Code Bills.
Hughes, H. R. Wood and C. B. Wood were named as a conference committee on house bill 11, the eminent domain code. The house refused to concur in the senate amendments.

The code committee recommended the passage of the following house bills: No. 7, license and occupation taxes; No. 11, initiative and referendum; No. 15, conveyance of real property.

Just one new bill was introduced in the senate. It is No. 63, by C. B. Wood, and is a modification of his bill fixing the hours of labor and minimum wages for the employees of service corporations, which was killed several days ago.

In its new form the bill simply requires that the corporation commission fix the wages and hours for work of public service corporation employees. Wood contends that since the commis-

sion has the right to fix rates and require certain standards of service its authority should also extend to the employees, that their interests may be safeguarded.

HIGH SCHOOL PUPILS HAVE "MURDER" TRIAL.
Annette Parker was the defendant in the mock murder trial which was on the docket of the English class, one A, of the high school Friday afternoon.

Annette was indicted by the grand jury of the English class. Nancy Edwards, chief counsel for the defense, expects to clear the defendant, by introducing in evidence the supposed dead man's collar, on which are a man's thumb prints. The charge of the court, which will be delivered by Walter Clayton, was prepared by sheriff Peyton J. Edwards.

The personnel of the high school "court" is as follows: Walter Clayton, judge; Amy Hitchens, Robert Marston and Mary Youngberg, representing the prosecution; Nancy Edwards, Ruth Morris and Mary Heermans, for the defense; Harvey Logan, sheriff; Marion Barnes, clerk of the court.

DR. FRIEDMANN HAS NOT REPLIED TO HEALTH BUREAU

Washington, D. C., April 23.—Communication between the health service here and Dr. F. H. Friedmann, the Berlin physician who claims to have discovered a tubercular vaccine practically has ceased, according to a report from the health bureau. Surgeon-General Hays said Dr. Friedmann there and he replied to letters written him by the bureau and that the department merely was waiting the results shown by patients already treated.

No direct reply has been received by the health authorities to their request for more vaccine or information regarding its manufacture, nor has there been an answer received from the letter to the doctor regarding the "making" progress of his American patients.
