

Cooper to Be Brought to El Paso

Man Now Held On Forgery Charge Was Once Reported Drowned.

San Antonio, Tex., March 11.—C. S. Cooper, under arrest here and said to be wanted in several states for alleged illegal check and draft operations, will be required to answer to a charge of forgery at El Paso before he is turned over to the officials of other states. Officers are coming from El Paso to return him to that city. There is no charge against Cooper here.

**Extensive Operations Alleged.**  
Los Angeles, Calif., March 11.—C. S. Cooper, under arrest in San Antonio, Texas, as a forger, is alleged by the manager of a bank detective agency to be wanted here for illegal check and draft operations which netted him several thousand dollars. According to the same authority, Cooper, who was believed to have been drowned in the Hudson river two years ago, has been operating for fifteen years in many states. Banks in various parts of the country have paid close to \$50,000 to him, it is alleged.

Cooper was arrested at San Antonio on a charge of forgery alleged to have been committed at Cordell, Okla. Banks, however, in New Hampshire, New York, New Jersey, North and South Dakota, Arizona, Texas and California are also said to have suffered. Cooper was arrested once in San

Diego, but left after his wife had posted \$500 bail for him. Afterward he was placed in an insane asylum in New York and Mrs. Cooper obtained a divorce. Later it was reported that he was drowned in the Hudson river. A body was identified as that of Cooper and interred under his name.

**EL PASO OFFICER TO GO AFTER THE PRISONER**  
C. S. Cooper, who is under arrest in San Antonio, Tex., on a charge of forgery, cashed a draft through the Rio Grande Valley Bank & Trust company in this city for \$180 about three weeks ago. The draft was drawn on a Los Angeles bank. The day following the payment of the draft, the city detective department received notice that Cooper was captured in many states and a search was made for him. He had gone, however. Sheriff Peyton Edwards says a deputy may leave for San Antonio tonight to get the prisoner.

POSTPONE CAPLES APPEAL TO APRIL 1

Austin, Texas, March 11.—State senator Claude R. Hudspeth was here today to submit the case of William Caples from El Paso county, pending in the court of criminal appeals, but the case was postponed until April 1. Caples was convicted of aggravated assault and given 90 days in jail. He is now out on bond.
