DISTRICT JUDGE IGNORING INDETERMINATE SENTENCE LAW. Austin, Texas, April 15.—Only a very small percentage of the district judges of the state are complying with the requirements of the indeterminate sentence law and as a result the court of criminal appeals, in passing upon cases appealed, is compelled to reform the judgments, according to captain E. F. Smith, clerk of the court of criminal appeals.

Under this law, where the jury assesses the punishment of the convicted person, when sentence is passed by the court it is provided that the court shall make the sentence for the minimum allowed for the offense, and the maximum at the term fixed by the jury, but the district judges usually pronounce the sentence at the term fixed by the jury.


KEEPING ACTIVE KEEPING EL PASO PLUMBERS BUSY


LEVINSKY LOSES FIGHT TO DILLON
