

FERGUSON AND BAILEY RINGS TO LOCK HORNS

Warm Time Expected When Democrats Hold Their Convention Here.

San Antonio, Texas, July 31.—Democrat county's delegation will give former United States senator Joseph Weldon Bailey a sharp rebuke at the state Democratic convention to be held at El Paso August 11. This is the result of the Ferguson victory in last Saturday's primary election and follows the statement made by the former senator in a recent interview in which he said Mr. Ferguson "won't be able to get his hand planted in the platform at the El Paso convention."

Ferguson men here scold this idea and call attention to the fact that not in recent political history of Texas has there been a Democratic convention which was not controlled by the Democratic nominee for governor.

"We will not only attend to Mr. Bailey in San Antonio," said a Ferguson man, "but we will attend to him at El Paso."

MONEY OBTAINED BY FILIBUSTERS TO RESUME WAR

Federal Refugee Sends \$40,000 Gold to Camp of Roque Gomez, at Palomas.

Filibustering activities are expected to be resumed in western Chihuahua. The local agents of Roque Gomez have obtained \$40,000 gold from a prominent federal refugee from Chihuahua. This money was sent to Gomez's camp near Palomas Thursday night and will be distributed among his men. The money was taken to Mexico by two agents of the filibustering junta in El Paso who left here on the Southwestern train Thursday evening. Ammunition has also been purchased in El Paso for the filibusters and will be smuggled across the line west of El Paso.

The federal movement has not been active since Huerta resigned as the money had been exhausted buying arms and ammunition and the men have been living on what they could forage from the ranches in the western part of the state. It is expected that they will start an active campaign against the remote rebel garrisons along the North Western railroad.

NEGRO BOYS CLAIM THEY WERE HELD IN SLAVERY.
Guthrie, Okla., July 31.—Charged with holding negro boys in peonage, James and Andrew Williams, farmers, were arrested Thursday by United States marshal Newell. It is charged that Williams had shipped to them 25 negro boys from Charleston, S. C., who, it is alleged, were worked as slaves on a Kay county farm. Last week one of the boys escaped and informed the officers. Three others who attempted to escape, it is said, were captured and received beatings which may result fatally.
