TUBERCULOSIS AGAIN LEADS AS CAUSE OF TEXAS DEATHS

Austin, Texas, Oct. 28.—Tuberculosis of the lungs again leads as the cause of death in Texas, according to the September report of vital statistics, made public today by registrar R. P. Babcock. There have been 216 deaths from this disease. Pellagra claimed 35 victims, while 28 persons died from typhoid fever. Thirty-four sets of twins were born during the month. The total number of births reported is 4413 of which 1919 were male and 2564 female. Total deaths were 10,000. One male white aged 35 years died from leprosy in a north Texas county. Of the deaths reported 12 were persons over 70 years of age.

U. D. C. BELIEVES GETTING NOT; MRS. C. E. KELLY WITHDRAWS NAME

Opposition to Mrs. Hamill for Reelection as President Develops at Wednesday Morning Session and President Retires from Chair Temporarily; Fight on Committee Report.

OPPOSITION to Mrs. Charles Leland Hamill, of Longview, for reelection as president of the Texas division and the withdrawal of Mrs. C. E. Kelly's name from the race for the presidency, marked the second day's session of the United Daughters of the Confederacy convention.

This is election day for the Texas division and all other topics have been dropped for the moment. The election will be held late this afternoon. A strong opposing faction developed in the convention Wednesday morning and forecasted a lively fight for the president's position.
