SHARP DECLINES CENTRE WHEAT. Corn Also Falls; Oats Follow Trend, but Are Not Heavily Unloaded. NOTE—Quotations reflect closing price Friday, November 27. Chicago, Ill., Nov. 27.—Unexpected sharp declines at Liverpool caused a heavy setback today in wheat prices here. Opening prices which were 4 1/2 to 2 1/2 c lower, were followed by a further drop, and then by a rally of about 1 c from the low point. The close was weak, 2 1/2 to 2 3/4 c net lower. Corn fell with wheat. After starting 4 1/2 to 1 1/2 c down, quotations recovered nearly all of the loss. The close was weak at 4 1/2 to 5 1/2 c net lower. Notwithstanding that oats reflected the weakness of other cereals, there was no general unloading. Provisions eased off a little, influenced by the course of grain.

PULLEN WINS ROAD RACE AT CORONA. Covers 200 Miles at 57 Miles an Hour, Setting New Speedway Record; O'Donnell Is Second. Corona, Calif., Nov. 27.—Eddie Pullen won the annual Corona automobile road race Thursday, covering the 200 miles at the rate of 57 miles an hour and setting a new speedway record. Eddie O'Donnell was second and Barney Oldfield third. Times were: Pullen, 3:28:23; O'Donnell, 3:28:18; Oldfield, 3:29:18; De Palma, 3:31:22. Pullen lost much time at the pits and to make his average he frequently tore over the two mile course at the rate of 100 miles an hour. The race was in doubt until the last lap. Pullen finished only two minutes, 45 seconds ahead of O'Donnell, who drove up from the rear toward the end, and Oldfield's little car flashed in but 40 seconds behind O'Donnell. Until the last few laps the strain of a mile a minute in excess of 55 miles an hour. Nineteen cars started. Eight went out before the 50th lap was reached and only six were going when the leader finished. Bursting tires twice jeopardized Pullen and only quick, cool work saved him. Once he cast a tire and the flying mass of rubber dashed into the grand stand, tearing off a section of rail, but no one was injured.
