Pullman Company to Pay. New York, Dec. 9.—After a 36 minute consideration of indignation and its kindred woes a justice in the United States district court awarded Mme. Della M. Valeri, a vocal teacher, \$2000 a year for the four year "tummy ache" which she says she contracted by eating a meal in the buffet of a Pullman car on a West Shore train bound for Lake Mohonk on Aug. 15, 1910.

Mme. Valeri in her suit against the Pullman company valued her stomach ache at \$2000. The \$2000 verdict has a sting to it. The jury arrived at its conclusion after having been charged by Judge Hand to base the finding solely on fact and not on law.
