ROAD BONDS TO COST BUT LITTLE

Will Not Cost Taxpayers 12 Cents on the \$100 Property Valuation.

On July 7, 1915, a special election will be held to put up to the qualified voters of El Paso county the opportunity to vote "yes" or "no" on a \$750,000 bond proposition for the construction of more and better permanent highways in the county.

The additional burden on the taxpayer of El Paso county to be occasioned by the passage of this \$750,000 road bond largely will not in any case exceed 11.9 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation, or \$1.19 per \$1000. It will probably be less, because of savings to be made in other directions.

Future Population Shares Cost.

The retirement of the bonds in equal proportions yearly for 40 years would mean the burden largely to the tax payers of today to the tax payers of the next generation, not to mention the large added population which is moving into the county during the term of retirement of these bonds and who will pay their share.

Advise Board of Citizens.

The majority of El Paso county voters having evidenced their confidence in the integrity of the personnel of the present board, it is fair to assume that the commissioners will use their best ability and discretion in the expenditure of the \$750,000 road bond issue after it passes.

The selection of this board is to be made by the commissioners. The board of directors of the El Paso chamber of commerce will be allowed to name one of the members. It is the wish of the commissioners to appoint as members of an advisory board, the men most highly qualified as to executive ability and knowledge of the work to be done.
