

PARKER MISSING; FEARED KILLED

Cattle Buyer Last Seen Behind Villa Soldier Near Casas Grandes.

Jack Parker, a well-known handler of cattle, was left El Paso on September 24, with \$200 in expense money to handle a movement of cattle, is missing and is believed to have been killed by Villa soldiers, according to a statement of J. P. Robinson of El Paso, and one of his warmest friends.

TO INSTALL NEW BISHOP NOV. 9

Bishop Schuler to be Consecrated in Denver Oct. 28; Big Reception.

The consecration of Rev. A. J. Schuler as bishop of the diocese of El Paso will take place in the cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Denver, Oct. 28.

Bishop Matz has been a lifelong friend of the bishop-elect who served as an acolyte under him when a boy. Archbishop Mayne will be assisted by the bishop of Cheyenne, right Rev. McGovern and the bishop of Tucson, right Rev. Grandon.

Installed Nov. 9. The newly consecrated bishop is expected to arrive in El Paso on Nov. 9 and on the day following will be officially installed as bishop in the cathedral of the Immaculate Conception.

When a bishop is to be consecrated there is a ceremony before the mass and it consists of the solemn presentation of the bishop-elect. The two assistant consecrators, who are bishops, clothed in cope and wearing the mitre, lead the bishop-elect, who is in white cope with brette, and presents him to the altar.

Practises Self. The examination was the bishop-elect practises himself at the left side of the altar.

of the consecrator, as the litany of praise is recited. At the prostration, the consecrator commences a long "prayer" which he interrupts during the singing of the "Veni Creator" and the choir, the bishop-elect with holy chrism, in the form of a cross and that part of the head which has been touched.

The consecrator resumes reading the "prayer" and at its conclusion, anoints the bishop's hands with the holy chrism, the head of the bishop-elect is bound with a linen band and the hands are fastened in the same manner; before the chrism has been cleansed from his hands, the consecrator makes the bishop-elect touch the crozier, puts the mitre upon his finger, makes him touch the book of gospels, and lastly gives him the kiss of peace, as do the two assistant consecrators.

Class of Consecration. The consecration proper is then over and the new bishop retires to the chapel prepared for him; he cleanses his head and hands from the chrism and continues the mass as far as the "offertory." Then the offering of two lighted wax candles, two small vessels of bread and two little calices of wine, one gilt and the other silver, takes place.

Cathroning the Bishop. The ceremony of enthroning the new bishop takes place before the last gospel. The consecrator, seated in the chair, assisted by two bishops, puts the mitre upon the newly consecrated bishop, then the gloves and the ring.

Concluding Service. The ceremony concludes with what is called the "Adieu." The consecrator and his two assistant bishops wearing their mitres, stand on the gospel or left side of the altar. The new bishop goes to the altar, or right side, and makes three genuflections towards the consecrator, advancing toward him at each genuflection, reciting in a low voice "Adiutus Abiis" (For many years).

After the third genuflection the consecrator raises his up, gives him the kiss of peace, as do the two assistant bishops and then the last gospel is recited ending the ceremony.

Chickens Do Not Wear Pajamas Keep Poultry House Warm These Cool Nights to Obtain Best Results From Poultry; Also Arrange Good Ventilation.

COOL nights have come and it is not inappropriate to discuss the question of housing poultry for the winter. Strange as it may seem the question of the proper house is far from settled. When I was a boy, even in Florida we had close houses to keep the flocks warm and at the same time protect them from the elements.

How to Build House. Now, briefly, I will go on record with my ideas for the exterior of a poultry house. The place for your poultry to sleep without reference to whether they are wintered or summered should be from front to rear and the height should be less than is usually found. The entire front should be secured with one inch wire netting.

Faces It South. The house facing south admits the early and continued rays of the sun with its drying and sterilizing influence. The sloping front enables you to use a lower roof and a low house is the desired one for the reason it is warmer than higher roofed houses there being less air space the warmth of the earth and of the fowls' bodies can more materially affect it.

An open space of a foot should be left at the bottom of the front for the exit of carbonic acid gas exhaled from the lungs and bodies of the fowls and which, being heavier than air, sinks to the bottom of the building. All other parts of the front being closed afford protection from north, east and west winds. The upper and front end of the roof should extend 18 inches beyond the front of the building and should have a drop of some kind to either as a hood or curtain to protect against a driving rain. A drop curtain to cover the upper open space in case of snow is much to be desired.
