A BRAVE LITTLE CONSUL WOMAN

Mrs. T. D. Edwards Shows the Grit of True American During Riots.

Across the river Monday, while troops rioted in the streets of Juarez, breaking into stores, stoning street cars, mauling and robbing wholesale, unheeded, for three hours, a little gray haired woman with a stiff backbone and plenty of American horse sense, sat in the United States consulate and administered the business of the state department in the absence of her husband.

She was Mrs. T. D. Edwards, wife of the consul. She called up the Carranza consul in El Paso and told him what was happening, why it was happening, and what he could do to stop it. She talked with Gen. Fidel Aylla and asked him how the situation stood at noon. She "kept in touch" from 8 o'clock till long after night had blanketed the city in a darkness which threatened to encourage fresh and more violent outbreaks.

"Mrs. Consul Edwards" was in every body's mind, and her name passed everyone's lips. Was she in danger? Had the consulate been entered? Had she been killed? These were the inquiries often heard.

"I shall never go to the United States. I would die sooner than go to the United States where they hate me. I shall spend the remainder of my life in my home mountains with my faithful friends, where my enemies cannot reach me."
