


MEXICO WATCHES GERMAN TROUBLE

MOBS FORCE THE FIGHT AT PARRAL

Carranza Troops Compelled to Fight the Americans, Though Friendly.

What occurred at Parral as viewed by a Mexican who was compelled to enter into an attack upon the American soldiers, was told Wednesday morning at a local mining company office by a messenger who had been sent to Santa Barbara, and who was at Parral during the trouble between the American troops and the Parral populace.

"When the people became very excited at the presence of the soldiers the mayor of the municipality, Jose de la Luz Herrera tried to quell the disturbance and the commanders of the military talked with their soldiers and instructed them that there should be no hostilities.

"The people of Parral then said to the mayor and the soldiers: 'This is our country and it does not belong to you nor to Carranza, but to us and we shall kill these gringos.'

"Then," continued the messenger, "the crowds began to gather and all of the men had guns and the women had stones. The American soldiers moved to the outskirts of the town. To some of the Mexican soldiers the mob said: 'If you do not join with us in killing these gringos, then we will kill you.' Compelled to join the mob, this is how the Constitutional soldiers got into the running fight with the American soldiers.

"One of the leaders of the mob saw me standing in a doorway and said: 'You come and join in killing the gringos.' I crossed my fingers and said: 'I have no gun.'

"After it was all over I was told that I might get but if I told of what happened in Parral at El Paso I would be executed if I returned, and because of this I am afraid to go back.

"In addition to John W. Glas, the defendant in the suit are I. J. Gilchrist, Raymond Krupp, Victor Caruso and Charles Chadwick and company, of Albuquerque.

15 EXECUTED FOR PLOTTING IN THE CITY OF CHIHUAHUA SUNDAY

'MYSTERY CARS' GO TO THE ARMY ANTI-AMERICAN THREAT STOPPED

Shippers Evidence Much Anxiety and Rumors Hint it May Be Ammunition. Proclamation Issued in Torreon Says 'Death to the Gringos.'

Considerable anxiety was expressed by El Paso shippers over two mixed cars of choice groceries which left Juarez at 10 o'clock Tuesday morning over the Mexico North Western railroad for Casas Grandes. One of the cars had a freight charge of \$120, and the other a charge of \$22, in spite of the fact that both were 34 feet long, and carried virtually the same character of supplies.

"Shippers Show Anxiety. From the minute the cars crossed the river to the time they were given the stamp of approval of the Mexican officials, the shippers were on tenterhooks and pins. Representatives of the shipping firm kept the telephone wires busy asking when the shipment would go out; other representatives remained in the freight yards at Juarez until the train was well on its way.

"It is customary to sample every tenth box or package in a car. The manifest, in a case of unusual hurry, is sometimes accepted on its face. This was what happened Tuesday morning, as the two cars passed the Juarez side only an hour or so before the train went out and there was only time for the customs officials to examine the boxes of canned goods that were stacked near the doors.

"It is hinted it may have been a shipment of ammunition, and if that is what it was it was the first to go over the North Western railroad. The chief interest of the shipment is that the constitutional soldiers, who are placed on embargo on the shipment of supplies ultimately destined to the United States, have been cleared of their duties without munitions of war.

TEXAS HAS 72 TYPHUS CASES

Disease Has Had a Rapid Spread in State Since April 1, Says Report.

Austin, Tex., April 18.—The state health department today announced that typhus fever is becoming threatening in the state. Seventy-two cases have been reported since January 1, 24 of these since April 1. The cases are in 11 counties, seven on the border and four in the interior, as far north as Jones, and as far east as Anderson county.

NO TYPHUS AT BISBEE, SAYS OFFICIAL REPORT. Phoenix, Ariz., April 17.—There is no truth in the rumors that typhus fever is raging at Bisbee, according to official information received at the office of Dr. R. N. Loomer, state health officer. The Bisbee authorities confess ignorance regarding the source of the rumors, but feel sure they did not start in Bisbee.
