

AMERICANS QUIT CARRANZA JOBS

Hollingsworth and Perea Say Carrancistas in Sonora Are Friendly.

Dr. J. I. Hollingsworth, of Muskogee, Okla., who has been treating Carranza wounded in Sonora, for the last two years, and M. M. Perea, of El Paso, connected with the aviation corps of the Carranza government as master mechanic, arrived today from Hermosillo, Sonora.

They say, without any manifestations of hard feelings whatever between the natives and the Americans there. A large amount of artillery was concentrated at Hermosillo just after the Columbus raid, to be sent to the Carrancista officers only. It is still there, left on flat cars for further orders.

Carrancistas Friendly. During the excitement on the border, the commandant told the Americans that if any Villa sympathizers threatened or insulted them, he would have such offenders summarily shot.

Mexicans have taken the places vacated by Dr. Hollingsworth and Mr. Perea in the Carranza service. A dollar saved by buying goods produced elsewhere is a dollar thrown at your neighbor's birds.

HOUSTON, PALESTINE, HELD PRISONER

Hostage, Dead Taken Prisoner by Americans, Presses Knife Into Heart; Hostage Is Shot.

Columbus, N. M., April 21.—A Mexican mayor, taken prisoner by American troops to prevent further slipping from the town of which the Mexican was president, showed his resentment by committing suicide, according to the story brought here by a widely known trip in Mexico. He said the incident was verified by a number of officers of the American expeditionary force.



Neither Caused by Bandits; Villa Wounded; Stopped to Butcher a Cow. A number of Americans coming from Chihuahua, Sunday night and reaching Juarez shortly before midnight, brought word of the wrecking of two trains on the Mexican National railway line below Chihuahua. The wrecks occurred Wednesday, April 19, and Thursday, April 20. In the first wreck, which happened within 15 miles of Chihuahua, four persons were killed. In the second, which occurred between Chihuahua and Jimenez, there were 20 casualties.
