16 TRAINS OF CONN. REGTS. GOING EAST

Say East Coast Regiments Will Reach Tucumcari By Friday.

Sixteen trains carrying national guard regiments from Connecticut Massachusetts and New Jersey are due to reach Tucumcari, N. M., the eastern terminus of the El Paso & Southwestern railroad, some time Friday, en route to El Paso, according to private reports. Upon arrival here all the regiments except that from Connecticut will establish camps on the sites being selected by a board of army officers appointed by Gen. ARGENTINE AMBASSADOR DOES NOT EXPECT WARFARE

New York, June 28.—Romulo S. Naon, Argentine ambassador to the United States, issued a statement here today in which he said that while he had made an offer of mediation looking to the settlement of the differences between the United States and Mexico, he was "in candor confident that the present crisis will be peacefully settled."

CONUL GARCIA SAYS WAR IN MEXICO WOULD MEAN HELL; STILL HOPES FOR PEACE.

"All the good people of both countries ought to get together in the interest of peace, for war would mean hell on earth," said consul Andres Garcia, in the comandancia at Juarez Wednesday morning. He still clung to the hope that hostilities might be averted, and expressed the belief that neither side realized the meaning of a struggle of this kind.

PENNSY TROOPS EN ROUTE HERE

Will Add Three Regiments of Infantry to Brigades of Two Other States.

New York, June 28.—Orders were issued by Maj. Gen. Leonard Wood, Tuesday night for Pennsylvania and District of Columbia troops to entrain for the border at the earliest possible moment. The Pennsylvania troops were ordered to El Paso and those from the District of Columbia to Bisbee, Ariz.

INTERVENTION IS INEVITABLE

Congressman Smith Says Should Have Come When Fired Into El Paso.

Intervention in Mexico is inevitable and it would have been better if the United States government had begun the task before now, congressman W. R. Smith, who reached El Paso Tuesday evening, declared emphatically.

THREE SURVIVORS OF CARRIZAL TO DUBLAN; BATTLE REPORTED

A report was received in El Paso Tuesday afternoon that between 30 and 40 prisoners of the Carrizal army had been brought into Colonia Dublan under heavy guard and in motor trucks.

ALL SHOULD TRY TO PREVENT WAR

Consul Garcia said he had done all he could to keep peace in Juarez, adding that not a single instance could be shown of an American being insulted or mistreated in that town. He also declared that any American had been thrown in jail there, as had been rumored in El Paso.

RELIEF MEASURE MAY BE DROPPED

Washington, D. C., June 28.—Insistence upon its amendment to the house military drafting resolution, striking out the million dollar relief appropriation for dependents of enlisted men, was ordered by the senate today after a disagreement had been reported by conferees.
