Col. Carranza Driven Back By Bandits in Chihuahua; More Legalistas.

Private dispatches here today said that Carrancistas, under Col. Carlos Carranza, had been defeated by a command of 60 Villistas under J. Dominguez, west of Chihuahua city.

Another report current here Monday said that a number of legalistas had crossed the border into Mexico, near Presidio, Texas, and are concentrating a revolutionary band south of Ojinaga.

8 GENERALS ARE GIVEN DIVISIONS

Gen. Bell Says Here and Gen. Morton Will Come to El Paso.

San Antonio, Texas, Aug. 21.—Major Gen. Frederick Funston today gave out the tentative assignment of commanders of eight of the new divisions of the national guard. They will have to be confirmed by the war department and definite assignments also must await the signing of the commissions of some of the commanders by the president.

The divisional assignments are: Ninth: Brig. Gen. Wm. L. Sibert. Tenth: Brig. Gen. Charles G. Morton.

DEFEAT MEXICO, CATHOLICS URGE

Report Read During Convention Blames U. S. For Its "Swaying Policy."

New York, Aug. 21.—The annual report of Joseph Frey, president of the German Roman Catholic Central Verein, made public today in connection with the opening Sunday of the 15th annual convention of the American Federation of Catholic societies and the 12th annual convention of the National Federation of German Catholics, referred to the "swaying attitude of our government with respect to Mexico and declared that in the opinion of our best thinkers and leaders our so-called prosperity, chiefly due to traffic in munitions of war, will meet with an abrupt termination when peace shall have been established."

Hope for Peace in Mexico. Of Mexico the report says in part: "Owing to the swaying attitude of our government, the perpetrators of infamy and crime against the Catholic church and her servants have taken hold of the government there. We hope and pray that this poor country may soon be granted a just and peaceable government. I recommend the acceptance of appropriate resolutions expressing our opinion on this subject."

26 ARMY TRUCKS PASS THROUGH TO SAN BENITO

Twenty-six Packard trucks that have been seen with the punitive expedition in Mexico, passed through El Paso Sunday evening en route to San Benito, Tex., where they will be assigned to the different commands in that district. The trucks were handled by civilian drivers who have been with them since their arrival on the border, about one month ago.

MILITIA AND MEXICANS FIGHT ACROSS LINE AT NACO

Naco, Ariz., Aug. 21.—One Mexican was wounded and taken prisoner by District of Columbia negro militiamen in a skirmish across the line about a mile west of here Sunday night between a patrol of militiamen and a party on the Mexican side. More than 100 shots were fired.

Church services were held in all of the army camps Sunday morning, including the services at the U. S. G. A. huts in the camps. Holy communion was also held in a number of the camps for the soldiers and hundreds of soldiers attended the downtown churches Sunday morning.

RAIDING YAQUIS KILL WILSON

Guaymas, Mex., Aug. 21.—(By wireless to San Diego)—Fifteen starving Yaqui Indians on a food raid swooped down on a settlement 80 miles inland from Guaymas and killed a man named Wilson. It was learned here Sunday, Wilson, it was said, was not an American.

HIT ON HEAD WITH A RAKE
