

MEXICANS FIND NEW TORTURE

Hang Man By One Foot and Burn His Head Until Death Ends Agonies.

Hanged by one foot from a telegraph pole, with his head only a few inches from the embers of a fire which had burned almost all of the face away, the body of a Mexican was found Saturday in Bachimba canyon, south of Chihuahua City, by a foreign refugee who reached the border Tuesday.

Another refugee, a Mexican of the middle class, who also reached the border Tuesday, said he had been an eye witness to the slaughter of 192 women and children camp followers of the Carranza force which had defended Santa Rosalia on December 22.

600 VILLISTAS ARE DEFEATED

Murguia's General Captures Much of Loot Taken From Chihuahua City.

Andres Garcia, inspector general of Mexican consulates, received a dispatch Tuesday from Gen. Francisco Murguia at Chihuahua City that Gen. Eduardo Hernandez, of his forces, had inflicted a severe defeat on 600 bandits left by Villa in the vicinity of Guereiro to guard the loot taken from the recent occupation of Chihuahua City.

According to Gen. Murguia's dispatch, the Villistas lost 140 prisoners, 25 dead and many wounded. Gen. Hernandez captured 400 rifles in his order, eight cannon, 6000 shrapnel shells, 2000 hand grenades, several machine guns, one Reber gun, 15,000 rifle cartridges, four cars of provisions, one car of clothing and many other elements of war.

EXPOSITION AT SAN DIEGO ENDS

Attendance Figures During Second Year Slightly in Excess of 2,250,000. San Diego, Calif., Jan. 2.—The Panama-California International exposition closed its career at midnight Monday night with the distinction of having been open for the public continuously for two years. Among congratulatory telegrams received by president C. A. Davidson was one from president Wilson, which read: "May I not convey to the San Diego Exposition association my warm congratulations upon the completion of that unique and valuable service to the art and industry of the country." (Signed) "Woodrow Wilson." The attendance during the year is estimated by exposition officials in excess of 2,250,000, slightly under the record established in 1915. The main buildings and landscapes, the beauties of which were the attractions, will be preserved. Although formally closed, the board of directors announced the exposition would be unchanged for three months. A number of exhibits, including the Canadian and French exhibits, will remain in the city. Other exhibits which are to be permanent will be enlarged by additional exhibits under a plan for continual enlargement. With the sounding of flags followed by the rendition of "Auld Lang Syne" by Mme.
