KEEP UP UPON GRAIN EXCHANGES OF MARKET; FORCE PRICES DOWN, BOARDS DECIDE

Temporary Restrictions Ordered in Effect Yesterday Will Be Continued Indefinitely, Representatives of Grain Exchanges Recommend and Chicago Board of Trade Acts; Others Follow Suit, It Is Expected.

CHICAGO, Ill., May 15.—Representatives of the leading grain exchanges of the country at a meeting here today recommended to their respective exchanges that they continue until further notice the restrictive regulations which were put in effect yesterday.

These regulations varied but little in the various exchanges—eliminating day options and curtailing operations in July and September wheat by fixing a maximum price; permitting selling but no buying except to liquidate existing contracts.

Many Exchanges Represented. The exchanges represented at the meeting were: Minneapolis chamber of commerce; St. Louis merchants' exchange; Kansas City board of trade; Omaha grain exchange; New York produce exchange; Duluth board of trade; Toledo produce exchange; Winnipeg grain exchange and the Chicago board of trade.

A committee made the following announcement: "The delegates assembled in Chicago today, representing the leading grain exchanges of the country at a meeting here today recommended to their respective exchanges that they continue until further notice the restrictive regulations which were put in effect yesterday.

The Chicago board of trade immediately put the recommendations into effect and it was said that other exchanges would without question do likewise.
