This gives you a quart of milk between meals, drink a glass of half milk and half cream with each meal, and at bedtime, if you feel you must have coffee, try it the French way, which is to pour a quarter cup of strong coffee in three quarters of a cup of very hot milk. This tastes delicious, not like weak coffee, but like very rich strong coffee.
