U. S. NOW HAS 725,000 ARMED

Few Drafted Men Need To Be Transferred To Fill Up Present Army.

Washington, D. C., Aug. 8.—Statements issued by the war department in relation to the new national army are being called by draft show there will be a surplus of about 150,000 men when 48,000 are called into the service.

The national guard, when taken into federal service August 5 had 15,000 officers and 418,847 enlisted men. The regular army today has only about 200,000 men.
