


That Rookie from the 13th Squad By P. L. Crosby

British Officer Says Allies Will Teach This to the Germans.

"There is no such word as can't in the English language and the United States and Great Britain will teach this to the Germans before we are finished," said Lieut. J. A. Crozier, of the British army, on recruiting duty in the United States, speaking before the High school pupils at assembly period Monday morning. He was closing his address and he waved the British and American flags as he made the declaration.

"There is no half way place in this war," Lieut. J. A. Crozier, of the British-Canadian recruiting mission, said Sunday, in addresses in Temple Mt. Binal.
