CHICAGO POLLS ENORMOUS VOTE

With Six Candidates For Mayor, One of Bitterest Campaigns Ends.

Chicago, Ill., April 1.—Elections of the city are awaiting for mayor and other city offices today, after a campaign said to have been the most bitter in the history of the municipality. With six candidates in the field for mayor, partisans, religious and racial hatreds flamed high during the campaign, which ended last night with riotous scenes in the central district, which extra police details had difficulty in controlling at times.

List of Candidates. Candidates for mayor are: Wm. H. Thompson (Republican), incumbent; Robert M. Sweitzer (Democrat), county clerk; Mackey Hayes (Independent), state's attorney; John Fitzpatrick (Labor), president, Chicago Federation of Labor; John M. Collins (Socialist); Adolph S. Carm (Socialist-Labor).

Women and Men Vote. It was the theory of students of local politics that the Fitzpatrick vote would come largely from Democratic women and that the vote for Hayes would be recruited largely from that which would normally go to the Republican candidate, mayor Thompson. Women as well as men are eligible voters, and a total vote of 700,000 was predicted.

Ten Minute Talks On Teeth

By M. G. FOX, D. D. S. ARTICLE 2. What Happens When the Nerve Is Dead. IN MY first article I told of the decay of the tooth because of improper structural development, and of the different stages it passed through until the death of the nerve.

All the soft tissues of the body contain a large amount of nitrogen. When the nerve tissues die and decomposition breaks them up into their original elements, they give off nitrogeneous gas. This gas, being formed inside the solid walls of the tooth cannot escape, except through the opening at the end of the root, carrying with it some of the decomposed and infected tissue, and stagnant blood. This sets up an irritation just outside the end of the root, destroying all the little arteries, nerves, veins and delicate attachments to the wall of the tooth, and in the jawbone it lies around it. Between the cup in the jawbone and the root of the tooth, which it sits in, is a narrow space, filled with a spider-web-like tangle of supporting fibers that hold the tooth in place. This space is larger just at the tip of the root of the tooth, to permit of a triangle of blood vessels—arteries and veins—and the trunk nerve, and contains a soft padding of tissue which acts as a sort of cushion or packing to prevent a violent shock to the nervous system when the tooth moves up and down in their sockets with considerable freedom during mastication.

It is not generally known to the layman that the teeth move up and down in their sockets with considerable freedom during mastication, but this is the case. The tooth is really a sort of floating tool, as it were, supported in the socket and kept free from the jawbone walls around it by thousands of delicate fibers, with one end fastened to the root and the other to the walls of the jawbone cup. As the nitrogen gas and infected matter work out of the root hollow into the space between the tooth root and the jawbone walls, they first destroy the delicate structure at the tip
