DEMORALIZED REDS MUTINY

London, Eng., April 19.—Development of the Siberian offensive against the Bolsheviks on a large scale is described in official dispatches from Omsk received today by the Russian embassy here and the definite prediction is made that all the Volga territory will be occupied this spring.

Men On Rhine Express Wish To Come Home

Applaud Daniels When He Mentions Their Return; Ask "How Soon?"

Coblenz, Germany, April 19.—(By Associated Press.)—Secretary of the navy Joseph Daniels, speaking to the men of the second division of the American army of occupation Friday, told his audience that he hoped the army would be taken home as soon as possible.

Mr. Daniels contrasted Friday's assurance with that of the Germans, who stood on the same ground in 1918 before beginning the war. "Their chief," he said, "had violence of conscience in the world, but America entered the war without deliberate territorial aims."
