

U. S. CASUALTY LIST IS REVISED

Shows a Total of 286,044; Battle Deaths, 48,900; Wounded, 237,135.

Washington, D. C., May 16.—Revised figures made public yesterday by the war department showed that the total casualties of the American expeditionary forces during the war was 286,044.

Casualties by Divisions. Casualties by divisions and the losses of each division in prisoners, which are listed, are included in the total.

First Division: Battle deaths, 237; wounded, 11,592; total, 11,829. Second Division: Battle deaths, 1,419; wounded, 7,894; total, 9,313.

Third Division: Battle deaths, 1,037; wounded, 6,627; total, 7,664. Fourth Division: Battle deaths, 271; wounded, 2,117; total, 2,388.
