Big Four Will Pay Dividend By Christmas

One Hundred Percent Expected; Not Less Than 25 Percent.

"Big Four stockholders will have received definite news of the present status of their investment," said George H. Pomeroy. "Since well number one, block 27, N. W. Burkhardt, came in on September 27 the company has indicated to interested friends that a substantial dividend would be forthcoming.

"No assurance could be made as to time and size of dividend, for the reason that pipeline facilities have been made ready to handle the production. No. 1 well in block 27, is equal to the best in this famous pool, and the Big Four company has another well in the adjacent holdings in that block. That can be finished up inside of a day and turned into the pipeline, which will be done as soon as pipeline connections with another company can be effected.

"In addition to these two producers, the company has machinery ready to day to drill the third well in its tract in 21. When assurance is received that all pipeline will be ready, the third well will go down without delay.

"Big Four stockholders can look forward to a profit from their investment. The company has been conservative in estimates placed before the public. However, taking into account the holding of the stock, the company has not been prompt to make certain promises, except for the prospect that pipeline conditions might delay getting immediate dispatch for the large production. It is believed, however, that the company will be able to pay a dividend of not less than 25 percent before the end of the year.

DRILL AT ONCE AT ROSWELL, N. M.
