

**FIELD GROWS AT WICHITA FALLS**

**New 2000 Barrel Wells Extends Northwest End of Burk Burnett Field.**

Wichita Falls, Tex., Dec. 2.—A 2000 barrel well has been completed, extending the extension of the Burk Burnett field about a quarter of a mile northwest. It is the No. 9 of C. B. Jackson in block 94. This well is attracting much attention as it is in a territory which has been considered hazardous drilling land on account of salt water.

This company holds 40 acres in block 94 under lease and already has four other wells going down.

The Rock Island railroad is now considering the best route to be taken in laying a line into Wichita Falls. A surveying party will be in the field at an early date.

This new line will run north and south, giving greater strength to the city as an oil and refining center. It will also materially aid in making Wichita Falls an industrial and jobbing center.

**700-Barrel Well In Shallow Sand At Homer Field**

**Gas Encountered in Trosper No. 2 at Depth of 2950 Feet.**

Shreveport, La., Dec. 2.—The Louisiana Oil and Refining company has a 700 barrel well from the shallow sand in the Homer field. It is the company's No. 4 on the Jackson leases in section 24-21-2.

The Shaw No. 2, section 20-21-2, of the Gilliland Oil company, is pumping 64 barrels of oil per day. This concern has a 4,000,000 cubic foot gas well in its Shaw No. A-2, section 20-21-2. The drill struck the gas sand at 1775 feet.

The Shafter Oil and Refining company's Arde No. 1 is making 300 barrels of oil from a sand around 2725 feet. This well is in section 15-15-11, Red River Parish.

In Panola county, across the Texas-Louisiana line, the Gulf Production company has encountered gas in its Trosper No. 2 at a depth of 3550 feet. The flow is estimated as 1,000,000 cubic feet. This well was started several years ago by the Palmerton Oil company. At that time the well made a small pumper.

**Largest Gasser In World Struck At Amarillo, Tex.**

**Great Difficulty Capping Hole of 100,000,000 Cubic Foot Well.**

Amarillo, Tex., Dec. 2.—The largest gas well in the world has been brought in by the Amarillo Oil company in Potter county.

This well is making between 100,000,000 and 120,000,000 cubic feet of gas per day. It is in section 105, block 105, of the T. & P. railroad survey.

Much difficulty is being experienced in capping the 12 inch hole, if the well continues its initial production. Texas cities will have ample gas for all needs within a short time.

**PREPARING FOR DEEP TEST OUTSIDE OF IOWA PARK, TEX.**

Iowa Park, Tex., Dec. 2.—The service is being hailed for the Comco Oil company's No. 2 deep test, which is to be drilled in this vicinity.

The location has been made on the Mamie Dale Brown farm, a mile and a half southeast of Iowa Park. It is believed that this test will do much toward extending the territory covered up by the hydraulic in the Kemp-Manger-Allen well, several weeks ago. The well will be drilled with cable tools in the shallow field. The shallow sand will be passed up.

**WELL FLOWING 15,000 BARRELS**

**King Midas Company's Gusher Recleaned and Comes Back Strongly.**

Brackensridge, Tex., Dec. 1.—While the flow of the Harris No. 1 of the King Midas Oil and Gas company has not been definitely estimated yet, the approximate rating of the flow is fifteen thousand barrels a day.

The well is four miles southwest of Caddo, Stephens county, a week ago it was shut for the third time. After being cleaned out it broke loose flowing very heavily.

The well has just been cleaned out again responding with the fifteen thousand barrel flow. Close to this well is the Carey 14,000 barrel gusher of the Mid Kansas Oil company.

**EAST ENTHUSIASTIC OVER TEXAS OIL, SAYS RINEHART**

E. Rinehart, president of the Texas Oil exchange, who returned Tuesday from a business trip to Fairbury, Chicago and Kansas City, declared Wednesday that he found eastern brokers enthusiastic over Texas and Louisiana oil stock.
