ATTORNEYS PLAN SURPRISE AT MADINE JURGENSON TRIAL

A special panel of jurymen, called for the trial of Madine Jurgenson charged with the murder of her husband, was examined by Judge W. D. Howe in the 31st district court Wednesday morning. Out of a panel of 74 men only 13 remained after examinations were granted.

Judge Howe notified attorneys that the selection of the jury would begin at 3 p. m. Wednesday. It is expected that of the 13 remaining a number will disqualify through prejudice and bias.

Attorneys for both the state and the defendant have been reticent regarding the line of testimony they intend to pursue, but it is expected that surprising developments will arise.

Mrs. Jurgenson is alleged to have entered the room of her husband, from whom she was separated, some time ago and to have shot him after she discovered him hiding under a bed. Mrs. Jurgenson testified she shot the man when he was hiding and said she shot only after he had started to attack her.

Officials of the court expect the taking of testimony to begin Thursday morning.

WOMEN PASSENGERS FAINT AS ELEVATOR CRUSHES CHILD

Denver, Colo., June 22.—Women passengers fainted yesterday when an elevator in the state capitol crushed the life of Howard Munkin, 11 year old grandson of state treasurer Harry Munkin. The child was caught between the floor of the ascending elevator car and the top of a shaft.

The body weighed the car and passengers were forced to remain in their places until rescued by firemen.
