

RATE ADVANCE IS EFFECTIVE AT MIDNIGHT

Carriers Petition For Bigger Increase on Infrastate Railroad Rates

WASHINGTON, D. C., Aug. 24.—Increased transportation charges on practically all railroad and steamship lines of the country will become effective at midnight tonight.

The general increases approximate 25 to 30 percent in freight rates, 20 percent in passenger fares and excess baggage and 10 percent in rates for Pullman accommodations.

Washington, D. C., Aug. 24.—A fortnightly steamship service between this port, the Azores and Portugal will be inaugurated by the arrival of the Morningstar, the first passenger steamship operated by the Portuguese government.
