I., Nov. 18.—Only citizens of the Philippine islands or of the United States, or corporations, composed wholly of citizens of either of these countries or both, may make application for leasing of petroleum lands of the public domain, or for the privilege to work and develop deposits of petroleum or other mineral oils or gas on lands of private ownership, according to a decision of the Philippine council of state.
