The Bill Passes.

WASHINGTON, D. C., April 25—It took the House just one minute and forty-one seconds to pass the declaration of war after the bill was reported. It was passed at 1:19 p. m.

Following is the bill reported by the House Foreign Affairs Committee declaring war to exist between the United States of America and the Kingdom of Spain:

"Be it enacted by the House and Senate of the United States of America in Congress assembled:

"First—That war be and is hereby declared to exist and that war has existed since the 21st of April, A. D. 1898, including Sunday, between the United States and the Kingdom of Spain.

"Second—That the President of the United States is hereby directed and empowered to use the entire land and naval forces of the United States, the militia of the several states, to such an extent as may be necessary to carry this act into effect."
