Rosalia has a Champ Clark club of 50 charter members.

Free city mail for Toppenish is to start on May 1, 1912.

Hanford fruit growers have effected an organization.

The city of Spokane recently foreclosed on 500 tax claims.

Walla Walla is seeking to secure the democratic state convention.

The Hanford canal when completed will have 11 miles of the bed cement lined.

An increase of 6390 names is now shown in Spokane's new directory just published.

E. J. McCaustland of Seattle, succeeds J. R. Yocum on the state board of health.

The Washington State Bankers' association will meet in Tacoma the latter part of June.

Two carloads of 3,000 trees each were recently shipped from a Toppenish nursery to Kelowna, B. C.

Julius Vaugan and E. J. Plemons were arrested in North Yakima last week on a charge of "white slavery."

Gov. Hay has issued a proclamation setting aside April 11th for Arbor Day and April 12th for Good Roads day.

NEWSPAPER LAW AS TO LAWYERS

Judge James Ellison of the Kansas court of appeals handed down following decision in the case of J. Austin of the Butler Record Burge, other members concur and published in 137 S. W. re- L. Ala., page 618:

The preparation and publication of a newspaper involves much mental and physical labor as well as an outlay of money. One who accepts paper by continuously taking it from the post office receives a benefit and pleasure arising from such labor and expenditures as fully as if he had appropriated any other product of another's labor and by such appropriation he must be held liable for the description price."

Speaker Champ Clark tells of a Missouri lawyer named Strange who became ill and feared he was about to die.

Calling his wife to him, Lawyer Strange said:

"Now my dear, when I die, I would like you to put a little headstone at my grave and on it simply say, 'Here lies an honest lawyer...'"




