CHICAGO, Nov. 29.—The continuance of weakness abroad, together with the loss in the cash premium at home, forced a sharp decline in nearby wheat options today. Closing was a half cent lower for December, 1/4 cent for the May, and a gain of 1/4 cent for the July option.

Foreign markets were weak all day, and at all points a lower price was shown at the closing. Liverpool opened 1/4 @ 1/2 under yesterday, and closed with a loss of 1/2 @ 3/4. Paris was easy, 1/2 @ 1/4 lower at the closing for wheat, and 1/2 @ 1/4 lower for flour.
