

'Let's Have Real Dukes and Lords in U. S.' Is New England Suggestion for This Fourth

Descendant of Daniel Webster Calls for Amendment to Constitution to Allow Titles of Nobility—Wants Them for Descendants of Men Who Have Been of Service to Nation.

DR. RUSSELL'S LETTER TO SENATOR LODGE Dear Senator: I inclose herewith copy of letter which I am sending to the governor of each state in the Union.

In view of your own distinguished ancestry and your eminent services to the nation you will sympathize with the spirit of the communication.


As a citizen of the commonwealth of Massachusetts and one of your constituents and admirers, I ask you to introduce a measure in congress to amend the constitution so that the provision preventing the government from granting titles of nobility may be repealed.

This should be followed by a bill to distinguish the descendants of such heroes as Washington, such statesmen as Marshall, and those whose ancestry can be traced back, like your own, to the pioneers of New England.



SPRINGFIELD, Mass., July 4.—Believing that the descendants of the founders of the nation, revolutionary heroes and men who have done distinguished service to the nation should be honored with titles of nobility, Dr. John P. Russell of Springfield, Mass., a relative of President Adams,



Van Ness, has asked Senator Henry Cabot Lodge to introduce a measure in congress to amend the constitution so that the provisions preventing the government from granting titles of nobility may be repealed. 



Lincoln has no special significance to them. Their respect for these great heroes and statesmen is not further enhanced when they see that the descendants of the great men of the country are looked upon as no better than other men whose ancestors have done nothing in the structural work of the nation.

"At first the alien experiences a feeling of surprise which is quickly followed by one of contempt for a country that does not reward its great men and descendants of great men with titles that will distinguish them from those who have done nothing and whose ancestors have done nothing. My critics will cry: 'We must not create a separate class; we must not create a separate class; we must avoid anything that savors of a monarchy.' But have we not already a class here? Who can in truth deny it? We have in the United States an aristocracy of gold, and the passport, through portals of this shoddy nobility is money, and quite often tainted money.

"Trace back the ancestry of four-fifths of the 'four hundred' of New York and you will find nothing to commend," continued Dr. Russell. "A man in the United States has only to discover some new and clever scheme for fleecing the public, and with his ill-gotten gains he may batter his way through the pastebored battlements of the American aristocracy here that will have nothing of the sham about it, an aristocracy that has for its foundation Ethan Allen, Daniel Boone, Daniel Webster, Lincoln and Gen. Grant, and other heroes and statesmen?"

"We must get away from the silly idea that the establishment of titles of nobility such as I have outlined will draw us away from the high ideals of the republic. Such logic is pure nonsense and has no basis or foundation. "With a nobility headed by dukes, tracing their ancestry back to Washington and Lincoln, lords, counts and baronets, through whose veins flows the blood of other great Americans, we would no longer be compelled to herald the antics of our moneyed aristocracy, and the people of this country would not be measured abroad by the brainless fools who travel throughout the world as leading Americans. "It may bring about hero worship, but that is far better than money bag worship."


