

The steamer Tampico arrived at the Tacoma smelter yesterday from Treadwell, Alaska, with 1330 tons of concentrates, valued at \$66,500.

Yesterday the British steamer Ophir left for British Columbia with 4100 sacks of plaster. Her cargo was taken on at the Pacific Coast Gypsum company plant.

The liner Watson of the Alaska Pacific Steamship company's fleet arrived at the Alaska-Pacific dock today.

Monday, the Hamburg-American liner Nicaria is due at Tacoma with a shipment of ore from the West Coast and also a hundred sacks of glue from Germany.

The British steamer Oceano of the Weir line arrived here this morning to load lumber at the St. Paul & Tacoma Lumber company's mills.

The United States cruiser Washington, which left yesterday for San Francisco, will carry seven Tacomans among its naval militia men. Those who are making the trip from Tacoma are: Capt. W. F. Andrews, who goes as navigating officer under Commander Freeman; W. L. Vergin, ensign in the militia, who will have charge of the Tacoma representatives; Henry Foss, quartermaster, 3d class; C. H. Holdridge, F. L. Webb, D. B. Peterson, Clarence Coombs, J. H. Gerron and E. G. Kelly. After leaving San Francisco, the Washington will assist in the celebration of the Chilean centennial at Valparaiso, and then will become a member of the Atlantic fleet at Hampton Roads.
