

Society All Fussed Up Over Sam Willets and His Two Wives




MISS AMBER LAWLORD AND MILLIONAIRE WILLETS.

DEMOCRATIC GAINS ALL OVER COUNTRY

(Continued From Page One.) re-elected to congress and republicans generally were successful.

Colorado DENVER, Nov. 9.—Both democrats and republicans today claim to have won the gubernatorial contest and the result probably will not be known before night.

Oregon PORTLAND, Nov. 9.—Save for the governorship Oregon yesterday went overwhelmingly republican and elected A. W. Lafferty, progressive republican and re-elected Congressman C. W. Hawley to congress by majorities ranging from 5,000 to 8,000 votes.

Oklahoma OKLAHOMA CITY, Nov. 9.—Lee Cruce, democrat, was elected governor of Oklahoma with a plurality of 30,000.

Nebraska OMAHA, Nov. 9.—Returns from 100 rural Nebraska precincts show that Chester H. Aldrich, republican, is leading in the race for governor by 9,000 plurality.

Montana HELENA, Mont., Nov. 9.—Re-

turns from all sections of the state today, though still incomplete, apparently remove all doubt that the republicans have made a clean sweep of the state and congressional offices and also assure the re-election of Thomas Carter to the United States senate.

On the face of the returns at hand early today Congressman C. N. Pray has been re-elected by at least 4,000.

Wyoming CHEYENNE, Wyo., Nov. 9.—The new legislature of Wyoming according to returns today is about evenly divided between the democrats and republicans.

Ohio COLUMBUS, O., Nov. 9.—Judson Harmon was re-elected governor of Ohio, according to today's returns, by a substantial plurality over Warren G. Harding, republican.

Indiana INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., Nov. 9.—Although early returns indicated that he had been defeated by John W. Kern, democrat, Senator Albert J. Beveridge, in a statement today expressed the belief that he has been re-elected.

Wisconsin MILWAUKEE, Nov. 9.—The entire state republican ticket was elected by about 40,000 plurality.

Iowa DES MOINES, Iowa, Nov. 9.—Cloude W. Porter, democrat, has been elected governor of Iowa by a plurality of 15,000, it is estimated today.

MISSOURI BOWLING GREEN, Mo., Nov. 9.—In an interview today Champ Clark declared he had been re-elected in the Ninth district by no less a plurality than he received two years ago when he defeated Judge Roy by 1,336.

Socialist for Congress MILWAUKEE, Nov. 9.—Victor Berger, probably the best known socialist in the United States, will have the honor of being the first socialist chosen to congress, unless returns should run badly against him.

No Bench for Me, Says Jones NORTH YAKIMA, Nov. 9.—United States Senator Jones who has just returned from the east where he campaigned for the republican party, today reiterated his denial of the rumor that he would consider retiring from the senate to take the place left vacant on the federal bench by the death of Judge Whitson, at Spokane recently.
