"PROFIT-SHARING SCHEMES TO EMASCULATE UNIONS." It comes from a pretty reliable source that J. P. Morgan and his lieutenants are working out a plan to introduce their "profit-sharing" and pension schemes in all the industries in which they

Their theory is that the workmen can be made happy if he is taken into the trust as a "partner." By being given a bargain sale to purchase a share of stock (or lose his job) the

workman becomes grateful and in some instances is inclined to swell out with pride as he thinks of himself and Morgan as partners.

The further theory is that the labor stockholders will work their heads off to insure a dividend of a couple of dollars per year, and under no circumstances would they think of demanding an increase in wages of a couple of dollars per week, for then they would be robbing themselves as stockholders and have no dividends coming.
