TOTAL ECLIPSE OF SUN FRIDAY TACOMA WON'T SEE IT, HOWEVER

SOME SUPERSTITIONS IN REGARD TO ECLIPSE.

Tomorrow afternoon a large portion of this world will go into deep mourning. Tacoma is just a little too far north to see any of the eclipse.

This will be the only eclipse, partial or otherwise, visible anywhere in America this year, for, while there will be an annular eclipse of the sun in the fall, it will be visible only in the eastern hemisphere.

The Chinese believe that during a solar eclipse the sun is being devoured by a great celestial dragon, and that only their prayers can save it from utter extinction.

The plous Hindu, before the eclipse comes on, goes through his house and carefully removes all cooked food, and all water for drinking purposes, because such food and water are made unclean by the eclipse, he thinks.

The savages of Africa beat upon drums, blow horns and stir up a terrible racket during the eclipse; their idea being that whoever is trying to steal the sun will imagine reinforcements are coming to the sun's aid, and will hotfoot it to safer regions.

In 1133, William of Malmesbury describes a total eclipse: "The elements manifested their sorrow at this great man's (that is Henry I.) last departure from England. For the sun on that day shrouded his glorious face in hideous darkness, agitating the hearts of men by an eclipse."




DIAGRAM SHOWING WHERE ECLIPSE IS VISIBLE IN UNITED STATES.

HAYWOOD PREDICTS VINDICATION

McNamara, international secretary of the Structural Ironworkers and his associates would be vindicated of all connection with the Los Angeles explosion and denunciation of the method employed in the arrests were made here today by William D. Haywood.

By William D. Haywood. The kidnaping of John J. McNamara from his offices in Indianapolis and the flight with him across the continent which is now in progress, is nothing new in the class war now on throughout the world. In 1906 President Charles

H. Moyer of the Western Federation of Miners; Adams, Pettibone, St. John and myself, members of that organization, were arrested in Colorado without a warrant, sequestered temporarily and later rushed 1,000 miles to Idaho to be charged with the murder of Steunenberg.

Like McNamara, we were given no chance to confer with our friends or families or to consult with an attorney. We were imprisoned for 18 months. Everyone knows the result of the trials. I predict that McNamara and his associates will be vindicated. It is remarkable how easily the wheels of the courts move in those instances when the workingman is accused of crime and how securely the safety clutch holds when any attempt is made to prosecute the capitalist.
