

TRUCE IN LONDON

(By United Press Leased Wire.) LONDON, June 21.—Threatened interference with the great coronation naval review was ended today when the striking seamen accepted a truce and agreed to man the boats which will carry the enormous crowds to the review off Spithead Saturday. The strike will be resumed Sunday unless in the meantime a settlement of existing differences is effected.

THIS MAYOR CUTS HIS OWN SALARY

(By United Press Leased Wire.) SPRINGFIELD, Ohio, June 21.—Mayor C. J. Bowlus of Springfield has cut his own salary from \$2,500 to \$1,500 a year in order to help the city of Springfield meet its just debts. He also says publicly that he does not propose to be the only one to give up money to the city and that he thinks after he has talked with a few other

city officials they will cut their salaries as much, proportionally, as he has. For the next year the city of Springfield will be run at the smallest possible cost. State laws have been mixed up a bit and local public improvements are heavy.
