## CITY GETS \$10,000 FROM THE T. R. & P.

The city gets \$10,901.44 as its share of the receipts of the street railway company for the last six months in Tacoma.

The amount was \$10,561.15 for the same period last year. This indicates a slight growth in business.

Two per cent of gross receipts go to the city on passenger fares and 5 per cent on freight business.

## Y.M.C.A. SENDS ANNUAL REPORT

It cost \$38,539.94 to run the Tacoma Y. M. C. A. last year, and the receipts were only \$30,289.91, according to the annual report just issued.

The expenses included \$21,944.08 for salaries for the secretaries, teachers, janitors, and others who do the work in the big building. There was \$3,618 of interest to pay on the debt still resting on the building.

In the receipts \$8,739 was raised from memberships, \$8,432 from rents and \$5,436 in subscriptions.
