FEBRUARY RECORDS ARE NOW ON SALE AT EILERS

Mary Garden, David Bispham, Orville Harrold and Other Celebrities on New List.

The new records for February are now obtainable at Eilers Music House, the Talking-Machine Headquarters. The February list is exceptionally noteworthy and is headed by Mary Garden, the Scotch-American woman who has made French opera famous in this country.

Bispham is again listed with a double-disc that comprises what are perhaps the two most perfect records that the great baritone has ever made.

Kathleen Parlow, the famous Canadian violinist, is represented by Auer's "Valse Bluettes" and the "Last Rose of Summer," one on either side of a double-disc record.

Orville Harrold, the famous American tenor who was introduced to record buyers recently in standard opera numbers, is this month featured in English song—the famous Godard's "Jocelyn Berceuse" and the favorite old Irish ballad, "The Snowy-Breasted Pearl."

Another record that will be particularly pleasing to Tacoma music lovers is that Jeska Swarty, the mezzo-soprano who created nothing short of a sensation here with the Alice Nielson Opera company.

OPERA HITS INCLUDED

Recent opera hits are strongly featured, for the list contains two selections, vocal and instrumental, from Lehár's "Count of Luxembourg" and further selections from "Oh! Oh! Delphine," the biggest light opera hit that New York has had for many seasons.

Then there are the two most popular sentimental songs of the season, "Fill the Sands of the Desert, Grow Gold" and "My Little Persian Rose," the former is sung by Frank Croston, the well known basso, coupled with the latter, presented by the Peerless Quartet.

ARE ALREADY WONDERFUL At last! Records by Cristeta Goni, the child violinist, whose platform work has recently been the sensation of two continents and who is this season making her first tour of the United States are now obtainable.

And for those who like something that they can tap their feet to, Prince's Band has played two new American marches—"On Jersey Shore" by Pryor, and "Pride of America," by Goldman.

Altogether, the new records are undoubtedly the most notable ever issued in any one month.
