


Mrs. Preston's Decision

Mrs. Josephine Preston, state superintendent of schools in Washington refused to prostitute her office to make it a weapon for politicians to use in a fight on socialism, and in a careful revision of the case of J. E. Sinclair, schoolmaster of Arlington, she refuses to revoke his license to teach.

Mrs. Preston points out that the charges against Sinclair are all based on the fact that he is a socialist, did not believe in the present American government and wrote violent socialist articles for a socialist paper.

She thought his actions in bad taste. She did not agree with his doctrines. She even felt he should not be continued in the schools, but she found nothing in his personal conduct that was either "unprofessional" or at variance with the normal rights of a school teacher as a citizen.

But it is to be hoped the time will never come when the state will go on record for discriminating against any man because of his political convictions. School boards may not employ him if they find he is indiscreet in his propaganda to the point of destroying his usefulness as a teacher, but it ought not to be a bar to the public schools because a man is a republican, democrat, socialist or prohibitionist.

Mrs. Preston is to be congratulated on withstanding the clamor of the gang that would have set a bad precedent in the educational system of the state.
