REILLY'S PLANS SECRET

What course Thomas Reilly, organizer for the Western Federation of Miners, will take to gain victory in the Ruston smelter strike, is the absorbing topic of interest at the smelter. Reilly has absolutely refused to announce any plans, has kept all meetings of strikers secret, and has refused to allow reporters to interview him on affairs pertaining to the strike.

Reilly is known to the professional strikebreakers hired by the smelter as deputy sheriffs. Several of the strikebreakers have clashed with the organizer at other strikes. They say that Reilly is a "fighter," but that he uses new tactics in handling every strike. Some of the strikebreakers recalled an occasion during a strike at Buffalo, N. Y., they said, when they captured Reilly and stripped him of his clothing in their search for weapons.

EIGHT MINERS BURNED

WHEELING, W. Va., Jan. 9.—Eight miners were badly burned in a fire which followed an explosion of gas on a mound of the City Coal company's mine at Moundsville, 12 miles south of

here, today. Four of them, with the upper parts of their bodies burned nearly to a crisp, were removed to a hospital, where they will die. The explosion occurred as the day shift was entering the mine.

DEPUTY QUILTS JOB

One of the deputy marshals hired through a Seattle detective agency quit his job today and announced that the grave trouble with the Ruston smelter strike was that the officers guarding the plant were unorganized and operating under entirely conflicting rules. There are three gangs of officers—deputy town marshals, deputy sheriffs and private detectives. These gangs work individually with individual orders, it is said. They are ordered one day to shoot to kill, and the next day given instructions to shoot only when actually forced to do so.

74 WOMEN GET MOTHER'S PENSION

Mothers' pensions have been given to 74 women since the passage of the law requiring it, according to the yearly statement of Charity Commissioner Watkins, turned into the county commissioners today. About 600 people were cared for last year, 400 of whom were children under 15 years of age.

Outside of the mothers' pensions, the expenses of the office were \$10,409.54. \$1,580 have been paid out in mothers' pensions.

LIGHT ELECTED AS DELEGATE

Game Warden Ira D. Wright was elected a delegate to represent the Pierce County Game association at the meeting of game commissioners and game wardens of Western Washington at Mount Vernon January 14 by the game commission of this county. Mr. Light has also been appointed a warden under the federal migratory bird law, by the bureau of biological survey, the game commission having consented to him serving.
