Notice is hereby given that on Monday, the 11th day of May, 1914, at the appointed polling place in the O'Donnell building, in the Town of Stellacoom, Pierce County, Washington, an election will be held for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said Town of Stellacoom, Washington, for the approval or rejection of the proposition, whether or not the Town of Stellacoom, Pierce County, Washington, shall borrow Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars, for the purpose of erecting, constructing, purchase of, acquisition, maintenance and operation of works, plants and facilities for the purpose of furnishing the said Town of Stellacoom and the inhabitants thereof and any other persons with electricity and other means of power and facilities for lighting, heating, fuel and power purposes, public and private, said works, plants and facilities to be owned, maintained and controlled by the Town of Stellacoom; and issuing the negotiable bonds of said Town of Stellacoom, for, according to Ordinances No. 137 and 138 of said Town of Stellacoom, said bonds to mature twenty (20) years after date of their issuance, with the option on the part of said town of paying same or any part thereof at any interest period after ten (10) years from date of issuance upon giving the holder thereof sixty (60) days written notice of the intention so to do, paying therefor the full amount of principal and matured interest to date of payment; said bonds to bear interest at the rate of six (6%) per cent per annum payable semi-annually, principal and interest to be payable at such place
