## ACQUITTED OF SMUGGLING CHINAMEN

SEATTLE, Dec. 11.—Frank H. Tape, former interpreter at the Seattle immigration station, and his two co-defendants, Chin Kim and China Dan, were yesterday acquitted by a jury in the federal court after a deliberation of three hours.

Tape, Chin Kim and China Dan were tried on an indictment charging them with having conspired to intimidate witnesses in the government's case against Tape for alleged bribery and extortion in unlawfully allowing Chinese to be brought into the country.

Immediately after the jury in the conspiracy case retired the work of selecting a jury to try Tape on the first of two indictments, charging him with accepting bribes, was begun, and following the acquittal of the three defendants in the conspiracy case, China Dan was arrested upon a secret indictment charging him with smuggling opium, as well as Chinese, into this country. On this latter charge two others were indicted with Dan, and it is expected they will be arrested today.

It is understood that China Dan's arrest yesterday and the two other arrests, will prove even a bigger sensation, involving, it is said, an unearthing of a traffic in both aliens and opium smuggling that has been conducted upon a big scale.
