

SEATTLE MAKING CLEANUP OF MILK

SEATTLE, April 27.—A bill providing that all dairymen who sell milk to Seattle must submit their cows to the tuberculin test if the milk is not pasteurized, was introduced in the council yesterday.

The proposed ordinance, which follows Tacoma's lead, is aimed to prevent the transmission of tuberculosis through milk, especially to children, who are particularly susceptible to attack.

The state law, which becomes effective in June, provides that dairymen may apply to the state to have their cows tested. After the tuberculin test, if a cow is found to be diseased, it is slaughtered or quarantined.

Parts of the animal, which may not be infected, may be sold under the supervision of the inspector. If the proceeds realized from the animal are not equal to the appraised value the state pays the owner the difference, this amount not to exceed the maximum of \$35.

Should a post mortem examination reveal the fact that an animal condemned was not suffering from tuberculosis the state will pay the owner not to exceed \$75. The government reports from the U. S. department of agriculture show that in thousands of tests not more than 3 per cent have been in error.

JOKER, PUNISHED ENOUGH, TOLD TO GO, JOKE NO MORE.

After remaining in the city jail since 2:30 Saturday afternoon, as the result of a practical joke of which he was perpetrator, Herman O. Schiffer, 2857 Ainsworth avenue, convinced Police Judge Evans today that he really was the victim of his own "joke," and was released.

Schiffer had wired Charles Falbisaner, an Everett man, an intimate friend, that he had \$256.80 of Falbisaner's money at his home. Falbisaner promptly had Schiffer arrested, charged with grand larceny.

Schiffer explained in police court yesterday afternoon that it had all been a joke, but did not make his "joke" plain to the court. Today, however, Judge Evans took Schiffer's word for it, and ordered him released. The case was technically continued until May 11, but Schiffer was told to go and joke no more.

ADVISES RAILWAY BOYCOTT

Tacoma shippers are advised to use steamship lines in preference to the railroads wherever possible, by Jay W. McCune, transportation expert of the Tacoma Commercial club, who has just returned from Washington, D. C.

There he attended the interstate commerce hearing where the request that they be permitted to make greatly decreased rates to intermountain points such as Spokane, Sacramento and other cities similarly situated.

McCune says the transcontinental railroads were frank in their admission that they proposed, now the Panama canal is open, to build up these other cities as distributing centers in preference to the Pacific coast ports.

This leaves the seaports only one effective course, says McCune—to ship by water.

READY TO PROTEST Germans Get WARD FOR INSANE St. Julien Back

LONDON, April 27.—Under a rain of shells, accompanied by a fierce rifle fire, and over all hanging the deadly fumes of the German asphyxiating bombs, the fighting in Flanders in a terrific attempt of the Germans to break the allies' line continues without sign of diminution.

Fighting along the part of the line held by the Canadians and English is slackening, due to the fact that both sides have turned their attention to a redistribution of the troops and a reinforcement of the present lines.

It has developed that the rejoicing in London over the announced retaking of St. Julien was premature. The Canadians did retake the point, but were obliged to fall back to Ypres.

Residents of the district near the county hospital are planning to protest the addition of an insanity ward.

This will be necessary if the county commissioners follow a law which the last legislature passed, providing a separate ward where suspected insane persons can be held 30 days.

The residents claim the holding of insane or suspected insane in the hospital would damage their property and have a bad effect on their children.

KEON PRINZ BILL GETS ORDERS TO RETIRE AS RAIDER
